Are there tryouts?

No. Everyone who registers will have a spot on the team unless it's full.

What does cheer registration include?

Full custom uniform.

What is the cheerleader required to provide?

Cheer shoes and a water bottle.

What does football registration include?

Full custom uniform.

What is the football player required to provide?

Helmet, Shoulder Pads, Cleats, Mouthpiece, Practice Jersey, Practice Pants.

- **Is there a specific brand or color?**

Helmets need to be white, preferably with a maroon facemask, but not required.

- Shoulder Pads do not require a specific brand or color.
- Cleats need to be Maroon, Grey or White (if possible) and no specific brand is required.
- Mouth Pieces should be Maroon, Grey or White, but not required. No specific brand is required but attached to facemask at all times.
- Practice jersey and pants need to be Maroon, Grey or White (if possible) and no specific brand is required.

How do I know what size equipment to purchase?

We will host equipment/uniform fittings during the 1st 3 weeks of May.

Where is the best place to purchase equipment?

We will provide a link to order white helmets with maroon facemask directly from Riddell at a bulk discounted rate! That link will only be open for a week. If you miss that window, you will have to purchase at full retail price from your local sports store or online from an equipment provider.

*****Used helmets must be reconditioned every other year. No helmet older than 10 years may be used.*****

Where are the games played?

How many games is the season?

You will have a game every weekend for 9 straight weeks unless you have a bye due to an odd number of teams.

Is there travel involved?
